Project Background

Orica is remediating around 25,000 cubic metres of soil contaminated with organic by-products from industrial activities which occurred between 1941 and 2000. The soil will be treated in a Directly-heated Thermal Desorption (DTD) Plant that is currently being



Progress Update

Since our last newsletter was distributed in May 2014:

- Clean soil, imported from a site in Merrylands with similar geology, has been processed through the plant to simulate contaminated soil operations – you may have seen the water vapour coming from the DTD plant stack; and
- The NSW Department of Planning and Infrastructure has approved the relevant management plans and systems to allow Orica to proceed with commissioning the plant on contaminated soil.
