REMEDIATION PROGRESS

- Since startup in 2006, the Groundwater Treatment Plant has treated 31,852 megalitres of groundwater, resulting in over 1,595 tonnes of chlorinated hydrocarbons being safely removed from the groundwater and destroyed.
- We are continuing with plans to safely have exported and destroyed legacy Hexachlorobenzene (HCB) waste.
